Thursday, September 24, 2026 - Early Childhood Inclusion: Building Belonging
GOALS:

- Support early childhood leadership teams in strengthening program capacity to expand inclusive preschool practices across the mixed delivery system -- ensuring all young children and their families experience belonging and thrive in their communities.
- Engage in learning around evidence-based practices that promote smooth and successful early childhood transitions and increase high-quality instruction for preschoolers with disabilities in their least restrictive environment (LRE).
- Collaborate with peers to cultivate and sustain a strong, shared culture of inclusion and belonging.

Friday, September 25, 2026 - The Champion's Path: Advancing the Pyramid Model

GOALS:

- Clarity & Inspiration: Discover how the Pyramid Model helps create inclusive early learning environments and prevents suspension and expulsion.
- Practical Tools: Learn strategies to use data to support children's growth, strengthen your practice, and partner with families.
- Connections & Collaboration: Build relationships with other early childhood professionals and explore ways to expand and sustain Pyramid Model practices in your community.
